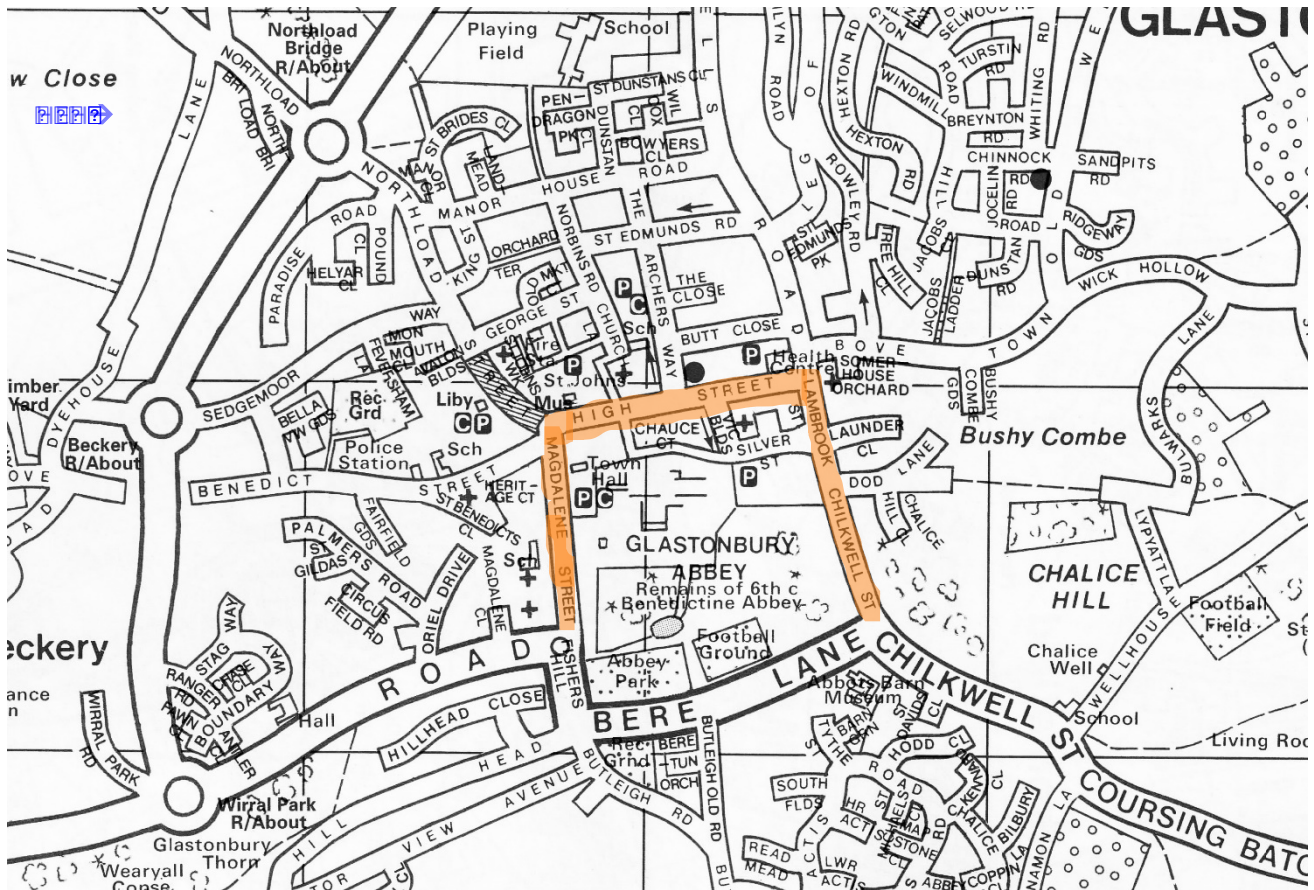


Diocesan Annual Pilgrimage to Glastonbury

Main de-bussing point for pilgrims:	Magdalene Street
Collection/Coach Boarding Point:	Magdalene Street
Disabled Persons de-bus and Car Park:	Magdalene Street
Coach Park - during Pilgrimage:	Northload Street Car Park Wirral Park Road, behind B & Q Store <i>(See separate map)</i>
Pilgrims' Car Park:	'Herbie's Field' Event Car Park, Northload Bridge. <i>Suggested donations: £5 per car, £10 per minibus.</i> Municipal Public Car Parks.
Pilgrims' Entrance to Abbey:	Magdalene Street Gate only - opposite the Shrine Church of Our Lady of Glastonbury
Entry to Abbey Grounds and Programmes:	After 12.00pm, only to Pilgrims displaying official badges. <i>Suggested donation £3 per adult, Children free.</i> <i>(Badges and programmes available from the Stewards' table at Magdalene Street Gate Pilgrims' Entrance.)</i>
Information Point:	Magdalene Street Gate, opposite the Shrine Church.
